State of South Carolina, situate on the Southeast side of Old Spartanburg Road (now East North Street), being known and designated as Lots 8 and 9 according to a plat of property of Eastlake made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1928, recorded in Flat Book G, pages 228 & 229, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
