THIS INDENTURE OF TRUST made and entered into this day of April, 1969, by and between Ambrose H. Easterby, Jr., hereinafter called "Grantor", and Ambrose H. Easterby, Sr., hereinafter called "Trustee",

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grantor has entered into a Separation and Support Agreement with his wife, Elliott A. Easterby, whereby as a part of said Support Agreement, the Grantor is to provide a trust establishing a home for the wife so long as she lives, or until she remarries; and

WHEREAS, the Grantor and his said wife have agreed upon said home which the Grantor is simultaneously with the execution of this Indenture transferring to the Trustee herein, in trust, to be held, managed, and disposed of by said Trustee in accordance with the provisions of this Indenture.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY COVENANTED AND AGREED by and between the Grantor and the Trustee as follows, to-wit:

- 1. The Trustee agrees to hold the aforesaid property in trust for the use and benefit of Grantor's wife, Elliott

  A. Easterby, for and during her natural life, subject, however, to the condition that should said Elliott A. Easterby remarry, then were upon maximum such event, all her right, title, and interest in and to said property shall forthwith cease and terminate.
- 2. Upon the death or remarriage of said Elliott A. Easterby, whichever shall first occur, said property shall thereafter be held, managed, and/or disposed of by said Trustee in Trust for the use and benefit of the children born of the marriage of said Grantor and Elliott A. Easterby according to the following terms and conditions, to-wit:
