Barnett did each receive al2/60ths interest in said lots.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Iola H. Pollard, her heirs and assigns forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves, our successors, heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Iola H. Pollard, her heirs and assigns against us and our successors and heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof;

SAVE AND EXCEPT HOWEVER the easterly portion of Lot 51 referred to above which is specifically excluded and exempted from the warranty in this deed.
