- Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property scribed below, or any interest therein; and
- 3. Hereby assign, transfer and set over to Bank, its successors and assigns, all monies now due and hereafter becoming due to the undersigned, as rental, or otherwise. and howsoever for or on account of that certain real property situated in the County of

EKKKKMXXXXX Spartanburgate of South Carolina, described as follows:

That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not Bank when due, Bank, at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or i ness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.
- That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places in its discretion, may elect.
- as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any parts on may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
