In the Decree which this Court entered in this case, it was ordered that the following Paragraph from the Decree be extracted and entered for record in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina. Such Paragraph is as follows:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff and the children be allowed to continue to occupy the home at 101 Brookside Way, which home is in the name of the Defendant. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff shall make the monthly mortgage payments on this home, including taxes and insurance, and the Defendant is restrained and enjoined from transferring or attempting to transfer title to Lots 73, 74, 75 and part of Lot 72 of Marshall Forest (101 Brookside Way) or from mortgaging or creating any lien against such property so long as the Plaintiff continues to occupy such home. In the event that she permanently vacates the home or remarries, her right of occupancy shall cease.
