ed by the Corporation for payment, the Corporation retains ownership of the lot until all charges due it are paid, and the Corporation reserves the right to remove the remains which may be interred on the lot, to a smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the original, or to a single grave in the

event that a default occurs in the agreed payment.

An order in writing is required of the lot owner whenever a grave is to be opened, containing the name, age, sex and residence of the deceased, and a permit from the Board of Health must be shown the Superintendent of the grounds before interment is made. If interment is to be made in the forencon, application must be made before 2 o'clock p. m. on the previous If in the afternoon, by 9 o'clock a. m. on the same day.

Lot owners shall at once notify the Corporation of any change in his or her post office address or name.

No disinterment shall be allowed except upon order of the Executive Officers of the Corporation, and upon the written order of the owner or owners of the lot, and in every case can
