Dillard, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and convey to the said C. S. Mattox and Wilson M. Dillard, their heirs and assigns, the following described property:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the northern side of Mimosa Drive and the eastern side of Beverly Lane, in the City of Greer, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and shown as the property of Lula Duncan Estate on a plat prepared by G. A. Wolfe, dated August, 1964, containing 5.25 acres, more or less, and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
