1. And between THE TOWN OF LANDRUM, SOUTH CAROLINA, municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina ( herein after referred to as "Seller") and DUKER POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of North Carolina ( herein after referred to as "Purchaser");

"I F A S S E T H:

That Seller, for and consideration of the sum of Four Thousand One, Nine Hundred, Ninety-One and 43/100 Dollars (\$4,991.43) in Gold money of the United States, to it in hand paid by Purchaser, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by Seller, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed, assigned, transferred and set over unto Purchaser, its successors and assigns, forever, those certain electric distribution facilities consisting of approximately 1.64 miles of electric lines, 50 poles, conductors, transformers, switches and other devices, being all of the electric facilities of Seller lying within the area in Spartanburg and Greenville Counties and known as the "Water Works Line".

It is understood and agreed between the parties hereto that this conveyance shall include any and all easements or rights of way for the location, operation and maintenance of the aforesaid electric facilities acquired either by grant or prescription, but that Seller does not make any representation that it owns any easements or rights of way, it being the intention of this instrument to convey only what Seller owns with regard to easements or rights of way for said electric facilities, and the general warranty hereinafter set out covers and includes only the personal property conveyed by this instrument.
