AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS FOR NASH MILL ESTATES A RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION IN GREENVILLE COUNTY, S. C.

It appearing that for the protection of the owner and purchasers of lots in Nash Mill Estates, that some latitude should be permitted with regard to the location of home sites on any single tract of said subdivision.

Now, therefore, Paragraph No. 6 of said Restrictions above captioned recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 918, Page 95, are amended as follows:

Ordinarily there shall be only one home site on any single tract but, nevertheless, more than one such home site shall be permitted on any single tract provided the approval in writing is obtained for the location of more than one home site on any single tract is obtained from a committee composed of Paul C. Aughtry, Jr. and Roy E. Nokleby, or by a representative designated by the said members of said committee. In the event of death or resignation of any member of said committee, the remaining member, or members shall have full authority to approve or disapprove any application for the location of more than one home site on any single tract.

Other than as hereinabove modified, the said Paragraph 6 shall remain as written.

This amendment to said restrictions are hereby made by the undersigned, who is the record owner in fee simple of all of the lots of Nash Mill Estates.
