Hewitt, Coleman & Associates, Inc., formerly
Company, Inc., as Lessors and/Robert F. Coleman, Inc., as Lessee.

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Homer Styles as Lessor and Robert F. Coleman, Inc. as Lessee, heretofore entered into a written Lease Agreement, dated August 28, 1967, covering a lot of land fronting 100 feet on the southwesterly side of U. S. Highways 25 and 276 and more particularly described by metes and bounds in the Lease Agreement, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the execution of this Lease, Homer Styles conveyed an interest in property surrounding and including the tract described in the Lease to Burgin Motor Company, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of amending the Lease Agreement hereinabove mentioned so as to give Lessee an additional 20 feet frontage on U. S. Highways 25 and 276 in consideration of Lessee releasing from the Lease the balance of the property described therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

The legal description contained in Paragraph 1. of that certain Lease between Homer Styles as Lessor and Robert F. Coleman, Inc. as Lessee, dated August 28, 1967 is amended by deleting it in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina containing .61 acres and having, according to a survey prepared by Carolina Engineering and Surveying Company, August 6, 1971, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of a creek on the southwesterly side of Highways 25 and 276, which point is 399.6 feet, S. 40-14 E. from the intersection of said highway and New Perry Road and running thence with said highway S. 40-14 E. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-13 W. 247.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-08 W. 97.1 feet to a point in the center of a creek; thence with the center of said creek N. 40-50 E. 50 feet and N. 41-0 E. 200 feet to the point of beginning.
