THIS SUBLEASE, made as of the first day of December, 1971, by and between ENERGY OIL COMPANY, INC., an existing Maryland corporation (hereinafter called "Lessor"), and CROWN CENTRAL PETROLEUM CORPORATION, of Baltimore, Maryland, an existing Maryland corporation (hereinafter

WITNESSETH:

THAT in consideration of the respective covenants, conditions and agreements herein contained, it is agreed by and between Lessor and Lessee as follows:

Lessor does hereby demise and lease subject to the provisions hereinafter set forth unto Lessee, its successors and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, described in Schedule 'A' annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

TOGETHER WITH all buildings, improvements and equipment thereon; and together with all rights, alleys, ways, waters, privileges, restrictive covenants, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining; and together with all Lessor's right and interest in and to all sidewalks, alleys and street spaces abutting the demised premises; and together with all the equipment listed on Schedule "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- II. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid premises unto Lessee, its successors and assigns, subject to the provisions of this Sublease, for a term of Sixteen (16) years beginning on the first day of December, 1971, and ending on the 30th day of November, 1986.
- pay to Lessor as rental for the demised premises the sum of One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00) in arrears on the 20 day of each and every month during the term of this Sublease. Lessee, its successors and assigns, further covenants and agrees to pay all rents
