C. Andrews, Surveyor, on November 1, 1905, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Page 194 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a chestnut oak corner, which is the northwestern corner of the O. P. Moore by deed dated March 7, 1940, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 222 at Page 98 and the said Anne M. Moore conveyed to Piedmont Corporation by deed dated March 16, 1940, recorded in Deed Vol. 222 at Page 41, The said Piedmont Corporation conveyed said tract to the grantors herein by deed dated March 21, 1947, recorded in Deed Vol. 309 at Page 256.

ALSO: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Cleveland Township, immediately to the north of the tract above described, being the southernmost portion of the "Gilreath-Wilson Tract" containing 76 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
