grant, bargain, sell quitclaim and release unto the said Carl D. Maxwell, his heirs and assigns:

All the right, title, and interest of the Grantors herein in and to:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract A as shown on a plat prepared by Webb Surveying and Mapping Co. dated December 1971 and entitled "Plat for Carl D. Maxwell" and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-M at page 105, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:
