

All that piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate on the West side of Buncombe Road (also known as South Carolina Highway No. 136) about 1 mile North of Pleasant Grove Church near the City of Greer in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, containing Fifty-One and twenty-seven/hundreths (51.27) acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at a nail and cap in the center of Buncombe Road and running thence S. 78-36 W. 1760.9 feet to an Old Iron Pin in Stone; thence N. 9-38 W. 651.8 feet to an Old Iron Pin; thence N. 58-30 W. 516 feet to an Old Iron Pin; thence N. 28-24 E. 78.2 feet to a Stone; thence N. 68-14 E. 2020.86 feet to a nail and cap in the center of Buncombe Road (Iron Pin back on line at 33.66 feet); thence running along and with the center of Buncombe Road S. 2-25 E. 100 feet; S. 5-25 E. 100 feet; S. 8-10 E. 100 feet; S. 11-35 E. 100 feet; S. 15-20 E. 145 feot; S. 18-00 E. 889.1 feet to the beginning point.
