Ellenburg and Hazel Redding Ellenburg. This release covers all past, present or future and prospective damages that might result or be claimed to result from the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and operation of the Department's highways, rightof-way and drainage facilities, as presently exist, including, but not limited to all matters as set out in their Summons and Complaint dated July 21, 1971 now pending in the Court of Common Pleas.

It is further acknowledged that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the Highway Department to do or omit to do any act or thing not herein mentioned, and that the above
