ALL our right, title and interest in and to ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on Woodruff Road, approximately one mile east of Lori Drive, containing one acre and being described according to a plat by Jones Engineering Service, dated February 1, 1972, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Woodruff Road at the corner of Hawkins property and running thence N. 6-30 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence with Smith property S. 80-16 E. 210 feet; thence S. 6-30 E. along Smith property 210 feet to Woodruff Road; thence along Woodruff Road N. 80-16 W. 210 feet to the beginning corner.
