Coker (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Shirley E. Coker, her heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Eastern side of Wood Road, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about one and one-half miles Southwest of Fairview School, containing 1.15 acres, and having, according to plat made by Campbell & Clarkson April 20, 1972, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book $\underline{\mathscr{YQ}}$ at page 73, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Wood Road at the Northwest corner of lot herein described and runs thence along the center of said Road S. 39-55 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Road S. 19-40 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Road S. 14-45 W. 60.4 feet to an iron pin in the center of said Road, at the corner of property now or formerly of James M.
