ises of the grantor so that the tops thereof shall be at the new grade of the grantor's premises.

- (c) No building shall be erected over said sewer pipe line nor so close thereto within said right of way as to impose any load thereon; and in no event shall any structure be erected within said right of way without the written consent of the grantee.
- 6. The payment and privileges above specified are hereby accepted in full settlement of all claims and damages of whatever nature for said right of way.
- 7. The grantor has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the grantee, its successors and assigns forever the property described herein and the grantor further does hereby bind its successors, executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular said premises to the grantee, the grantee's successors or assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
