RESOLUTION OF GREENVILLE COUNTY SEWER AUTHORITY CONCERNING CONDEMNATION AND TAKING OF RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER PROPERTY OF CONTROL PANELS, INC., AND AWARD OF DAMAGE THEREFORE.

Pursuant to notice duly given, a meeting of the Greenville County Sewer Authority was held at the offices of Hill, James, Fore & Wyatt, Attorneys at Law, 100 Williams Street, Greenville, South Carolina, at 11:00 A. M., April 12, 1972, and continued on July 25, 1972, at 9:00 A. M., for the purpose of determining just compensation and damages, if any, to be paid to Control Panels, Inc., for the condemnation of a right-of-way across property described in the Greenville County Block Book records as being Lots 6.3 and 6.4, deeds to said property being recorded in Book 827, at Page 36; and Book 924, at Page 72, and being designated as of October 1, 1971, on the Greenville County Block Books as being in District 298, Sheet 436, Block 3. The right-of-way required will be 50 feet wide during construction but after construction shall be reduced to 25 feet. Said right-of-way is to follow the route designated on plat prepared by Enwright Associates, Engineers, dated April 14, 1972. It was determined that a twenty-five (25) feet right-of-way would be all that was necessary for maintenance and repair of the lines after their installation. After full and complete discussion of the matter and the taking of testimony, and after due consideration:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Greenville County Sewer Authority, that the value of the right-of-way being taken, together with any special damage occasioned by the construction of the sewer line is, in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions, found to be One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot.
