The property referred to by this agreement is described as follows: All that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No.14, section 5, of Richmond Hills subdivision, recorded in plat book WWW page 38 of the RMC Office for Greenville County said lot subdivision, recorded in plat book www page 50 of the int office for Greenville County said to having a frontage of 100 feet on the northwest side of Konnarock Circle, a parallel depth of 150ft. and a rear width of 100 feet. This is the same lot conveyed to grantor by Williams Builders, Inc. by deed recorded Sept. 19, 1969 in deed vol. 876 page 151 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. and is conveyed subject to restrictions applicable to said subdivision recorded in vol 855 page 47, and to any recorded easements or rights of way or those shown on the ground.

- 5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
