ORDER

This matter came before me for hearing on August 7, 1972, upon verified petition of the Petitioner, seeking the closing and abandonment of certain streets in the American Spinning Community of Greenville County, South Carolina, pursuant to Sections 33-521 et seq. of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina as amended. I find that the Respondents were duly served with copies of the Summons and Petition and filed an Answer placing the rights of Greenville County and the public in the hands of the Court. The Respondents were represented at the hearing before me by the County Attorney, Honorable E. P. Riley.
