ELIZEAL PROPERTY AGREEMENT

In consideration of such loans and indebtedness as shall be made by or become due to THE SOUTH CAROLINA NATIONAL BANK OF CHARLESTON (hereinafter referred to as "Bank") to or from the undersigned, jointly or severally, and until all of such loans and indebtedness have been paid in full, or until twenty-one years following the death of the last survivor of the undersigned, whichever first occurs, the undersigned, jointly and severally, promise and agree

- 1. To pay, prior to becoming delinquent, all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below; and
- 2. Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein; or any leases, rents or funds held under escrow agreement relating to said premises; and
- All that lot of land in the cuty of Greenville, County of Greenville, state of South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 13, Block B, Section 1, on plat of East Highland Estates, recorded in clat book K pages 35-36 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to said plat and a recent survey made October 1956 the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the mortheast corner of the intersection of Carolina Avenue and Wait Street; thence with the eastern side of Carolina Avenue No. 31-33 W. 83 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 12; thence with the line of said lot No. 59-16 E. 189 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of a 5 Ft. strip reserved for utilities; thence with the southwest side of said strip for utilities S. 19-52 E. 27-5 feet to an iron pinn on the northwest side of wait Street; Thence to the northwest side of said Wait St. S. Thirly W. 10.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35-51 W. 61.1 feet to an iron pin; thence on any notes hereof or hereafter signed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from said premises to the Bank and agrees that any judge of jurisdiction may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the described premises, with full authority to take possession thereof and collect the rents and profits and hold the same subject to the further order of said court.

That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not paid to Bank when due, Bank, at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.
 - 5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.
 - 6. Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
