PURPOSE OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

The fundamental object and purpose of these restrictive covenants is to create a harmonious whole in the development or subdivision to prevent the building of any structure which would look odd, cheap or out of keeping, to insure the use of the property for attractive residential purposes only, to prevent nuisances, to prevent the impairment of the attractiveness of the property, to maintain the desired tone of the community, to preserve the value of the property owned and developed by the owners of lots and tracts in the subdivision and to secure to each lot or tract owner the full benefit and enjoyment of his home. Anything tending to detract from the attractiveness and value of the property for residence purposes will not be permitted.

USES PERMITTED AND PROHIBITED

- (1) All lots in this subdivision or development shall be known and described as residential lots and shall be used exclusively for single family residential dwellings. No structure shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any such lot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two and one-half stories in height and a garage for private passenger automobile and servants quarters.
- (2) No trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuilding erected upon any lot shall at any time be used as a residence either temporarily or permanently. No structure of a temporary nature shall be used as a residence and no house trailer shall be placed on any lot either temporarily or permanently.
- (3) No noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on anywhere on the property subject to these covenants nor shall anything be done thereon
