Mac Richardson, Surveyor, dated July 1959, and recorded in the R.M.C. BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Rockvale Drive at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 201 and 202 and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 87-36 E. 165 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lots No. 181, N. 1-58 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 202 and 203; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 87-36 W. 167.7 feet to an iron pin on Rockvale Drive; thence along the eastern side of Rockvale Drive, S. 3-49 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
