All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and in the State of South Carolina, on the north side of Ansel Street (formerly known as St. John Street), and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of Ansel Street, at corner of land now or formerly owned by John M. 
