H. Austin and Goldsmith, and being the same property conveyed to C. C. Coleman, Jr. and A. Lamar Campbell, Sr. by deed dated July 20, 1973 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 980 at Page 19, in which the said A. Lamar Campbell, Sr. did subsequently convey to the said C. C. Coleman, Jr. his undivided one-half interest by deed dated November 14, 1973, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 988 at Page 385,
