

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, James T. Lynn ,Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, of Washington, D. C., acting by and through the Federal Housing Commissioner, (hereinafter referred to as "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Thousand Two Hundred and No/100----- DOLLARS (\$ 18,200.00 ), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Douglas H. Harbert and Sandra F. Harbert (hereinafter referred to as ("Grantee(s)"), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s), the following described real estate situate in the County of Greenville , State of South Carolina, to wit:

All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 13, as shown on plat of Clearview Acres recorded in Plat Book MM, at Page 168, of the RMC office for Greenville County, S. C., said lot having a frontage of 100 feet on the north side of Clearview Circle a parallel depth of 175 feet, and a rear width of 100 feet.

Being the same property conveyed to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development by deed of Frank P. McGowan, Jr. Master, dated October 3, 1973, recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County, on October 12 1973, in Book 986, page 25.
