conveyed to Samuel A. Garrison in 1854 as recorded in the F.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book ZZ at page 24. This resulted in the complete ownership of said thirty seven and one-half (37 1/2) acres by Ella Tarrant Eskew.

In 1879, approximately twenty nine (29) acres adjacent to and on the northwest side of the above thirty seven and one-half (37 1/2) acres was acquired by James Augustus Garrison and Ann Elizabeth Rosman Garrison (Deed Book JJ, page 501); as related above, James Augustus and Ann Elizabeth Rosman Garrison never married and James Augustus Garrison died in 1918 and Ann Elizabeth Rosman Garrison in 1691, so that in 1918 this property was claimed and owned solely by Ella Tarrant Eskew as heir at law. (James Augustus Garrison and Ann Elizabeth Rosman Garrison died intestate, and their estates were not probated.) Approximately twenty four (24) acres of this portion was sold by Ella Tarrant Eskew in 1946 (Deed Book 308, page 76).

In 1892, one C. B. Tarrant conveyed eight (3) acres to James A. Garrison (Deed Book PPP, page 628). This eight (8) acres lie in the northeast portion of this 55.71 acres referred to herein. This property likewise was claimed and owned solely by Ella Tarrant Eskew upon the death of her brother James A. Garrison in 1918.

In the deed referred to above in which Ella Tarrant Eskew conveyed some twenty four (24) acres in 1946, (Deed Book 308, page 76) it was stated that Ella Tarrant Eskew was the sole heir at law of James A. and Ann E. Garrison.

my parents, and Charles C. Eskew died in 1906 and my mother, Ella Tarrant Eskew died intestate in 1948, leaving seven (7) children as heirs at law. These children or other heirs including myself, conveyed all of their right, title and interest in and to the above mentioned property (described as 51.4 acres, more or less, later survey reflects 55.71 acres) to Waymon Raxter, Ray Durham and Floyd Smith. The above 55.71 acres is therefore derived from the above mentioned 37.5 acres plus the approximately 5 acres (remaining after sale of about 24 acres
