NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of \$1 and mutual promises and covenants, the parties hereby agree that Restriction No. 6 Page 2, of the Restrictive Covenants applicable to lots shown on Plat of Hount Vernon Estates recorded in Plat Book 4X at Pages 12, 13, 14 and 15 shall be assended whereby the minimus square feet referred to in Restriction No. 6 shall be reduced from 2,200 feet to 2,000 square feet, and in the houses containing two-stories, the minicum ground floor area shall be reduced from 1,600 feet to 1,400 square feet on the lots hereinafter described in the subdivision.
