IN TRUST, NEVERTHELESS, FOR THE FOLLOWING USES AND PURPOSES:

- 1. To sell, transfer, convey, or otherwise alienate (or to retain for such time as to the Trustee shall seem best) in such manner, upon such terms and conditions and for such price as to the Trustee shall seem best. Together with the power to make, execute and deliver such instruments as shall be necessary to effectuate such sale, transfer or conveyance.
- 2. To pay all appropriate costs and expenses, as the Trustee may determine in connection with such selling, transferring, conveying or alienating and after deducting all costs and expenses to divide the net proceeds equally among Roger Hugh Stone, Kirk Louis Stone and Dena Joanna Stone.
