
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Vasiloos Nick Skent ris

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the northern side of West Stone Avenue being shown and designated as Lot #16 on a plat entitled "Property of Floride S.
