- 7. The filing of the petition by the debtor above named operates as a stay of the commencement or continuation of any court or other proceeding against the debtor, of the enforcement of any judgment against it, of any act or the commencement or continuation of any court proceeding to enforce any lien on the property of the debtor, and of any court proceeding commenced for the purpose of rehabilitation of the debtor or the liquidation of its estate, as provided by Rule 11-44.
- 8. In order to have their claims allowed so that they may share in any distribution under a confirmed plan, pursuant to Section 355 of the Bankruptcy Act, creditors, whether or not they are scheduled by debtor, including the United States, and states, and any subdivision thereof, shall file their proofs of claim before confirmation; provided, however, that:
 - (a) If scheduled by the debtor, a claim may be filed within 30 days after the date of mailing notice of confirmation to creditors but shall not be allowed for an amount in excess of that set forth in the debtor's schedules.
 - (b) A claim arising from the rejection of an executory contract of the debtor may be filed within such time as the Court may direct.
- 9. In the event the debtor is adjudicated a bankrupt on or before the First Meeting of Creditors, THE FIRST MEETING OF CREDITORS AFTER ADJUDICATION will be held at the same date, place and time as hereinabove stated.
- 10. The Court has been made aware that the debtor has heretofore had the benefit of an informal Creditors Committee composed of five persons, representing unsecured trade payables. The Court authorizes and approves the continuation of this Committee until the first meeting of creditors at which time any and all nominations for a permanent creditors' committee will be received.
