corporate shares, securities, or other property, real or personal, as to her seems proper in her absolute discretion, and her judgment as to the value of such shares, securities, or other property so alloted shall be conclusive on all parties. The Trustee shall not be required to make physical division of the funds except when necessary for distribution of corpus, but may, in her discretion, keep the corpus of the trust in one or more consolidated fund. The Trustee shall not be required to make any provision on account of the diminution or increase in value of any securities or investments at any time constituting a part of the trust herein created, or for the depreciation in respect of any tangible property, or for the purpose of amortizing or making good any amounts paid in premiums on the purchase of securities of any other property.

(P) The Trustee may freely act under all or any of the powers of this agreement given to her in all matters concerning the trust herein created, after forming her judgment based upon all the circumstances of any particular situation as to the wisest and best course to pursue in the interest of the trust and the beneficiary hereunder, without the necessity of obtaining the consent or permission of any person interested therein, or to the consent or approval of any court, and notwithstanding that she may also be acting individually, as trustee of other trusts, or as agent for other persons or corporations interested in the same matters, or may be interested in connection with the same matters as shareholders, directors, or otherwise, provided, however, that she shall exercise such powers at all times in a fiduciary capacity primiarily in the interest of the beneficiary hereunder.

The powers granted herein to the Trustee may be exercised in whole or in part, from time to time, and shall be deemed to be supplementary to and not exclusive of the general powers of trustees pursuant to law, and shall include all powers necessary to carry the same into effect.
