AGREEMENT TO CANCELL BOND FOR TITLE

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 142 on a plat of Berea Forest, Section II, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Geenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "4N", at Page 76 and 77, and fronting on River-Wood Court.

It is further agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that the Purchaser cancels said Bond for Title and forever relinquishes any right, title or interest, or equity he might have obtained in said real estate to the Seller.
