ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, with all the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, which is the eastern portion of the property shown on an original survey by Piedmont Engineering Service dated August, 1950, and which is described more particularly according to a more recent survey entitled "Property of W. R. Crossfield," by Jones Engineering Services, dated June 27, 1966, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of North Calhoun Street at the intersection of North Calhoun Street and a 10-foot alley; and running thence N. 70-51 W. 201 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19-04 E. 202 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-51 E. 201 feet to an iron pin on the western side of North Calhoun Street; and, thence S. 19-04 W. 202 feet along the western side of North Calhoun Street, to an iron pin, the point of beginning, this being the same property conveyed to the grantor corporation by deed of Calhoun Courts, Inc., dated Sept. 3, 1966, recorded in the RMCOffice forGreenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 805 at Page 402.

ALSO all that lot of land situate on the south side of Hilton Street (formerly known as River Street) in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lots 70, 71, 72, 73, 74 and a portion of Lot 69 on plat of Section 2 of Nickle Town Heights made by W. J. BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Hilton Street at the northeast corner of Lot 74 and runs thence S. 16-14 E. 295 feet to an iron pin in the centerof a branch; thence along the center of branch (the traverse line being S. 64-17 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in the joint rear corner of Lots 69 and 70; thence N. 29-30 W. 199.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-14 W. 130.5 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Hilton Street in the front line of Lot 69; thence along the south side of Hilton Street, N. 73-46 E. 708.1 feet to the beginning corner, this being the same property conveyed to the grantor corporation by deed of W. R. Crossfield, dated April 12, 1973, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville, S.C. in Deed Book 1003 at Page 660.
