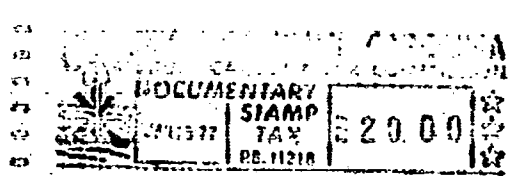

ALL that certain tract, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. This being a part of the land left to Leacy McMillian Patterson and Eva McMillian Noe by the Last Will of L. O. McMillian and known as Lot No. 2 of the sub-division of the L. O. McMillian Estate, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances.
