SECTION THIRTEEN

No bond shall be required of Trustee or any successor to Furthermore, no Trustee appointed hereunder shall at any time be held liable for any action or default in connection with the administration of the trust estate, unless caused by gross negligence of Trustee or an agent of Trustee or by willful commission by Trustee or an agent of Trustee of an act in breach of trust.
