EASEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this day of March, 1977, by and between DAVIDSON ENTERPRISES, INC., hereinafter called "Grantor", and DAVIDSON ENTERPRISES, INC., hereinafter called "Grantee".

WITHESERETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00)

Dollars and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor has bargained and sold and by these presents does bargain, grant and convey unto the Grantee its successors and assigns a temporary right-of-way or easement including the right to enter upon the real estate hereinafter described, at anytime that the Grantee may see fit, during the life of this easement or right-of-way, to instruct, maintain, and repair an underground septic tank drainfield for the purpose of serving a septic tank located on the property of the Grantee, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches for the allocation of said drainfield, and the further right to remove trees, bushes, undergrowth and other obstruction interferring with the location, construction, and maintenance of said drainfield.

The easement or right of way shall be effective until sewer is provided to the area at which time the Grantee shall tap on to the public sewer.

The land affected by the grant of this easement and right-of-way is located in Greenville County, South Carolina on the western side of Hudson Road and is more particularly shown as Lot No. 2 on a plat of property of Davidson Enterprises, made by C. C. Jones, Surveyor, dated December 30, 1976, recorded in Plat Book 5-Z at page 62.

Said easement begins on the southern boundary line of the Grantee's property shown as Lot No. 1 on a plat entitled property
