(1) KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Johnny L. Blythe
and

also, being designated in the Block Book as 248-2-143 and encroaching of
(our) land a distance of 70 feet, more or less, and being that portion of my (our) said 40 feet in width during the time of construction and 20 feet in width thereafter, and being shown on a prifile in the offices of Parker Sewer and Fire Subdistrict.
The Grantor(s) herein by these presents warrants that there are no liens, mortgages, or other encumbre to a clear title to these lands, except as follows: which is recorded in the office of the R.M.C. of the above said State and County in Mortgage Book at Page and that he (she) is legally qualified and entitled to grant a right of way with reto the lands described herein.
The expression or designation "Grantor" wherever used herein shall be understood to include the Mortgif any there be.
(2) The right of way is to and does convey to the grantee, its successors and assigns the following: The and privilege of entering the aforesaid strip of land, and to construct, maintain and operate within the limsame, pipe lines, manholes, and any other adjuncts deerned by the grantee to be necessary for the purpose of veying sanitary sewage and industrial wastes, and to make such relocations, changes, renewals, substitution placements and additions of or to the same from time to time as said grantee may deem desirable; the right limes to cut away and keep clear of said pipe lines any and all vegetation that might, in the opinion of grantee, endanger or injure the pipe lines or their appurtenances, or interfere with their proper operation maintenance; the right of ingress to and egress from said strip of land across the land referred to above for purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; provided that the failure of the grantee to exercise any or rights herein granted shall not be construed as a waiver or abandonment of the right thereafter at any time from time to time exercise any or all of same. No building shall be erected over said sewer pipe line nor so thereto as to impose any load thereon.
(3) It Is Agreed: That the grantor(s) may plant crops maintain fences and use this strip of land, provided the temporal plant of the planted over any sewer pipes where the tops of the pipes are less than eighteen inches under the surface of the ground; that the use of said strip of land by the granter shall not, in the operation of the grantee, interfere or conflict with the use of said strip of land by the grantee for the purpose I mentioned, and that no use shall be made of the said strip of land that would, in the opinion of the grantee, endanger or render inaccessible the sewer pipe line or their appurtenances.
(4) It is Further Agreed: That in the event a building or other structure should be erected contiguous said sewer pipe line, no claim for damages shall be made by the grantor, his heirs or assigns, on account of damage that might occur to such structure, building or contents thereof due to the operation or maintenance negligences of operation or maintenance, of said pipe lines or their appurtenances, or any accident or mishapmight occur therein or thereto.
