Said property shall be sold for the sum of Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$19,500.00) Dollars, in lawful money of the United States of America, and the Buyer, in consideration of the premises, promises and agrees to pay the Seller the aforesaid sum of money, for all of said real property, as follows to-wit: Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars upon the execution and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of Nineteen Thousand and No/100 (\$19,000.00) Dollars in installments, including interest In on all unpaid principal from date hereof until date of payment at the rate of eight (8%) per centum per annum. The first installment of One Hundred Eighty-one and 58/100 (\$181.58) Dollars to be paid September 1 , 1977, and a like amount shall be paid on the same day of each month thereafter until the balance of principal and interest has been paid in full. The amount of the final payment, however, shall be the total of the principal and interest then due. All payments to be made by the Buyer shall be paid with lawful money of the United States of America.
