- 6. To deal with any insurance adjuster, insurance companies, agents, or attorneys in regard to any claims or cases that I may have of every nature, including accident cases and to execute whatever documents may be necessary to settle, compromise, or end the same. However, my attorney in fact shall first obtain my consent for the settlement of any such case.
- 7. Giving and granting, unto my said attorney full power and authority to perform all and every act, deed, matter and thing whatsoever about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the fully complete and general power herein and not in limitation or definition thereon; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
- 8. It is expressly understood that this Power of Attorney shall continue in full force and effect until such time as the same is revoked by death or by subsequent written revocation of the same.


