## POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, Marie C. Pace, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, have made, constituted, and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint my daughter-in-law, Mary P. Batson, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, (hereinafter referred to as "my Attorney") my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name, place, and stead to do the following acts and to exercise the following powers, and I intend that, subject to the definitions hereinafter contained, the same be construed in the broadest possible manner:

- (1) To endorse any and all checks, drafts, or vouchers, and to cash the same or deposit their proceeds; to sign and issue checks on any bank account in my name; and to make, execute, and deliver, cancel, modify, buy, sell, exchange, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of any tangible or intangible property of mine by means of any type instrument necessary or advisable to accomplish the same.
- (2) To manage, operate, protect, and conserve all securities, properties, interests, and investments owned by me; to collect, hold, or pay out or otherwise deal with the income therefrom or the principal thereof; and from time to time make investments for me without any restrictions whatsoever as to the kind of investment.
- (3) To enter into, perform, modify, extend, cancel, compromise, or otherwise act with respect to any contract of any sort whatsoever.
- (4) To procure insurance against any and all risks affecting property or persons, and against liability, damage, or claim of any sort; to alter, amend, extend, or cancel such insurance.
