the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and I, Eric presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto **Edwin S. Roberson and Marie M. Roberson**, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot. "c. 17 of a subdivision known as Store Lake Heights, Section No. 4, as shown on plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects on July 5, 1964, revised in October, 1965, and recorded in the R.M.L. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book PIB, at page 159A and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Ashford Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots No. 17 and 18 and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 36-46 W. 200.0 feet to an iron pin at the corner of lot No. 19; thence along the joint line of Lots No. 17 and 19, following a 10 foot utility easement, N. 2-10 W. 125.0 feet to an iron pin at or near a creek; thence S. 85-51 W. 16.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots No. 16 and 17; thence along the joint line of said lots S. 36-19 E. 274.1 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Ashford Avenue; thence along the northern side of Ashford Avenue S. 53-41 W. 110.0 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to drainage and utility easements which appear on the recorded plat, particularly a 25 foot right-of-way for a sanitary sewer line which runs along the rear end of the lot, and is also subject to restrictions and protective covenants recorded in the R.W.L. Office for Iraeville County in Deed Volume 791, at page 78.

The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to the late E. H. Stone and the late Anna S. Stone by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. PPP, at Page 157. The said Anna S. Stone died in or about the year 1918, leaving a will wherein she devised her interest to her husband, F. C. Stone. The said F. C. Stone died in the year 1935, leaving a will wherein the bulk of his estate was devised to the above named trustees under a testamentary trust. The grantors, Irene H. Stone, Jr. and Alexander W. Stone are trustees under an inter vivos trust created by the trust agreement above mentioned, recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 1124, page 24, called Stone Enterprise Trust. The grantors Hallie S. Marion and Ann S. Cleveland join in this conveyance to satisfy a requirement of the Stone Enterprise Trust that 55% of the beneficial owners express their consent to a sale.
