2. The Bank may require payment of all or part of the outstanding amount due under this Note. The terms hereof Bank's election may
be set forth in a separate instrument or this Note may be converted into such instrument. Such instrument shall make Bank to be due and payable forthwith.

3. The Bank may exercise any right or power herein given to it by law or by the instrument referred to in paragraph 2 above, in such places as Bank in its discretion

6. The present instrument is to be construed as being on the same terms as the original instrument and shall have effect and until then it shall apply to all
deeds and documents executed before the date of this instrument by the original executors and trustee and shall be to the benefit of Bank and its successors
and assigns. This instrument is to be construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Any witness or witness to whom a copy is made shall be and constitute
a witness to this instrument.
