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THIS DEED, made this 15th day of May, A.D., 1978, between SEABOARD COAST LINE RAILROAD COMPANY (successor of Piedmont and Northern Railway Company), a Virginia corporation, hereinafter called "Grantor"; and BUDWEISER OF GREENVILLE, INC., a South Carolina corporation, whose mailing address is 1436 Oakdale Street, Columbia, South Carolina, 29201, hereinafter called "Grantee";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said premises unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, in fee simple forever; SUBJECT, However, to reservations, conditions, restrictions and easements of record.

Except as to the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph, Grantor hereby binds itself that the premises are free from encumbrances, that it is seized of said premises in fee and that it will fully warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto Grantee against Grantor and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Grantee hereby agrees, as a part of the consideration of this conveyance, to construct within one year from July 26, 1978 on the land hereby conveyed, the following:

A warehouse containing approximately 25,000 square feet of floor space which includes offices, conference rooms and sales offices, as well as a cooler storage area
