he was unable to purps himself of contempt. In the Anril 13, 1978 Order, the sentence of the Court was suspended so long as the Defendant was hospitalized. I find up to April 10, 1978 the Defendant was in violation of the particulars of the Court's January 16, 1978 Order specifically in that he had failed to make child support payments, had failed to obey the Court's restraining order enjoining him from visiting the premises of the former marial abode, and in failing to adhere to the other particulars of said Order. The Court takes into consideration Defendants allegations that his health is poor, however, IT IS HERDBY ORDERED that the Defendant, Edward S. Coster should be held in contempt of Court and sentenced to six (6) months in prison or a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100ths (\$759) Dollars. This sentence is hereby SUSPINIOND, FROVIDED the Defendant shall obey and comply fully with all previous Orders of this Court including, but not limited to, payment of all back child support.

IT IS, THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUGCED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:
TO: ZDWARD S. COSTER:

- (1) You are hereby held in contempt of Court and sentenced to six (6) months in prison or a fine of Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100ths (\$750) Dollars, SUSPENDED on the provision that you fully comply with all previous Orders of this Court;
- (2) You are hereby restrained and enjoined from selling, transferring and conveying any interest in or in any manner affecting your property rights and your one-half interest in the former marital residente until further Order of this Court; as of the Court previous Order;
- (3) You are hereby restrained and enjoined from going onto the premises of the forcer marital abode until further order of this Court;
- (4) You are to comply with all particulars of the previous Orders of this Court including but not limited to the payment of all back child support.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
