ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and lying on the northern side of Gower Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the corner of Sallie J. Johnson's lot on Gower Street and running thence along Gower Street S. 65-50 E. 50 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence N. 28-50 E. 217.5 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence N. 61-50 W. 50 feet, more or less, to a stake on Sallie J. Johnson's line; thence S. 28-50 E. 217.5 feet, more or less, to Gower Street, the beginning corner. This lot is known and designated as Block Book No. 76.3-6-37.

This is the same property conveyed to T. H. Johnson from O. P. Mills, Trustee for S. C. Mills, M. C. Croswell, A. G. Gower, Charles E. Gower and Lola C. Carpenter and is recorded in Deed Volume RRR, page 497, on January 24, 1906.
