SUB-LEASE AGREEMENT

this indenture of LEASE, made and entered into this 18th day of May, 1978, and executed in duplicate, by and between Outlaw Industries, Inc., a South Carolina corporation having its principal place of business in Greenville County, South Carolina (hereinafter referred to as "Lessor") and Diane Young Sportswear, Inc., a New York corporation having its principal place of business at 1250 Broadway, New York, New York, 10001 (hereinafter referred to as "Lessoe");

## WIINESSETH:

In consideration of the rentals, covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, and intending to be legally bound thereby, Lessor and Lessee do hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1.
