ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot No. 33 on plat of Section I, Burlington Industries, Inc., which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJJ at Page 10, and having, according to a more recent plat thereof entitled "Property of Charles W. McHugh, Jr.", dated February 13, 1979, prepared by Freeland & Associates, recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C. Office in Plat Book 6-2 at Page 98, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
