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Know All Men By These Presents, That I, H. D. Porter,

in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$9,500.00) DOLLARS to me paid by CHARLES LEE HIGHTOWER, III AND LISA MINDY HIGHTOWER in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CHARLES LEE HIGHTOWER, III AND LISA MINDY HIGHTOWER, Their Heirs and Assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the northwestern side of the South Saluda River and being designated as Lot No. 5 according to a plat of J. B. Chastain, Surveyor, dated April 8, 1949, said plat being recorded in Plat Book 7 at page 105, said lot having the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING at a point in the middle of Poplar Springs Branch approximately 15 feet from the Greenville Valley Line and running thence N. 04 E. 26 feet to an iron post marked J. B. 60 x. 161 feet to the center of South Saluda River; thence in a southeasterly direction from the center of said River 70 feet to a point in the center of said river where Poplar Springs Branch empties into said River; thence in a northwesterly direction following the boundaries of Poplar Springs Branch a distance of approximately 215 feet to the point of beginning and containing .25 acres, more or less.
